LOUISVILLE WATER COMPANY TOUR PROGRAM

Every day Louisville Water Company provides over 130 million gallons of safe drinking water for people in Louisville Metro and parts of Bullitt, Nelson, Oldham, Shelby and Spencer counties. Created in 1860, Louisville Water Company was the first water utility in Kentucky. The tour combines history and science to help children and adults understand the importance of safe drinking water.

Tour Information

Louisville Water's tour program is available for children in grades two and higher.

- Tours are offered Monday through Friday 9:00-2:30pm from March through November 1st.
- Tours begin at the Louisville Water Tower, 3005 River Road and include the historic Water Tower and pump station, the current pumping station and the Crescent Hill Reservoir. The tour also includes hands-on science experiments.
- The tour is free; you provide transportation. For bus scheduling, it's two stops for the bus. The bus remains for the tour.
- The maximum number of students for a tour is 60. Louisville Water Company requires one adult for every six children.
- Chaperones cannot bring other children.
- The tour is mostly outside; dress for the weather! Tours are rescheduled in case of severe weather.

Safety is a Priority!

- Everyone must wear sturdy walking shoes, no flip flops, crocs or sandals.
- Since the tour is near water and large equipment, good behavior is a must. Children who are disruptive will be asked to go back to the bus.
- Chaperones must be responsible for their group of children.
- Lightning will cancel tours.
